



## 2024-2025 Rate Sheet

### Special Education Day School Tuition:

<b>Tier 1</b>	Tier 1 students are typically able to function productively in classes with 4-6 students with periodic behavioral support or counseling.	<b>\$275/day</b>
<b>Tier 2</b>	Tier 2 students typically require classes smaller than 4 students, frequent 1-on-1 assistance with behavioral difficulties, and/or more intensive counseling.	<b>\$335/day</b>
<b>Tier 3</b>	Tier 3 students typically require 1-on-1 instruction and/or dedicated behavioral support in order to function productively in the school setting.	<b>\$505/day</b>

This tuition includes all classes, textbooks, lunch, activities, trips, and other educational, therapeutic, and recreational programs and services provided by the school during the regular school day (8:15 AM - 3:15 PM). The tuition does not cover any tuition or fees required for students to dual enroll in courses for college credit.

Individual counseling with a Licensed Professional Counselor. Available in half hour increments	<b>\$120/hour</b>

### Minimum Cancellation & Settlement Policy

If the placing agency wishes to terminate a student's enrollment at Bear Creek Academy, they must inform the school administrator in writing of the termination in accordance with the placement agreement between the school and the placing agency. The school will make refunds to the placing agency within 30 days of the date of the student's withdrawal from school.

If the school terminates the student's enrollment for any reason, the school will make refunds to the placing agency within 30 days of the date that the student's enrollment was terminated. In cases where a student's termination involves destruction or defacement of school or other property, the school may withhold any refunds until the student has compensated the school for the repair or replacement of the damaged or defaced property.

In case of prolonged illness or accident. death in the family, or other circumstances that

make it impractical for the student to continue to attend the school, the school shall make a settlement which is reasonable and fair to both parties.
